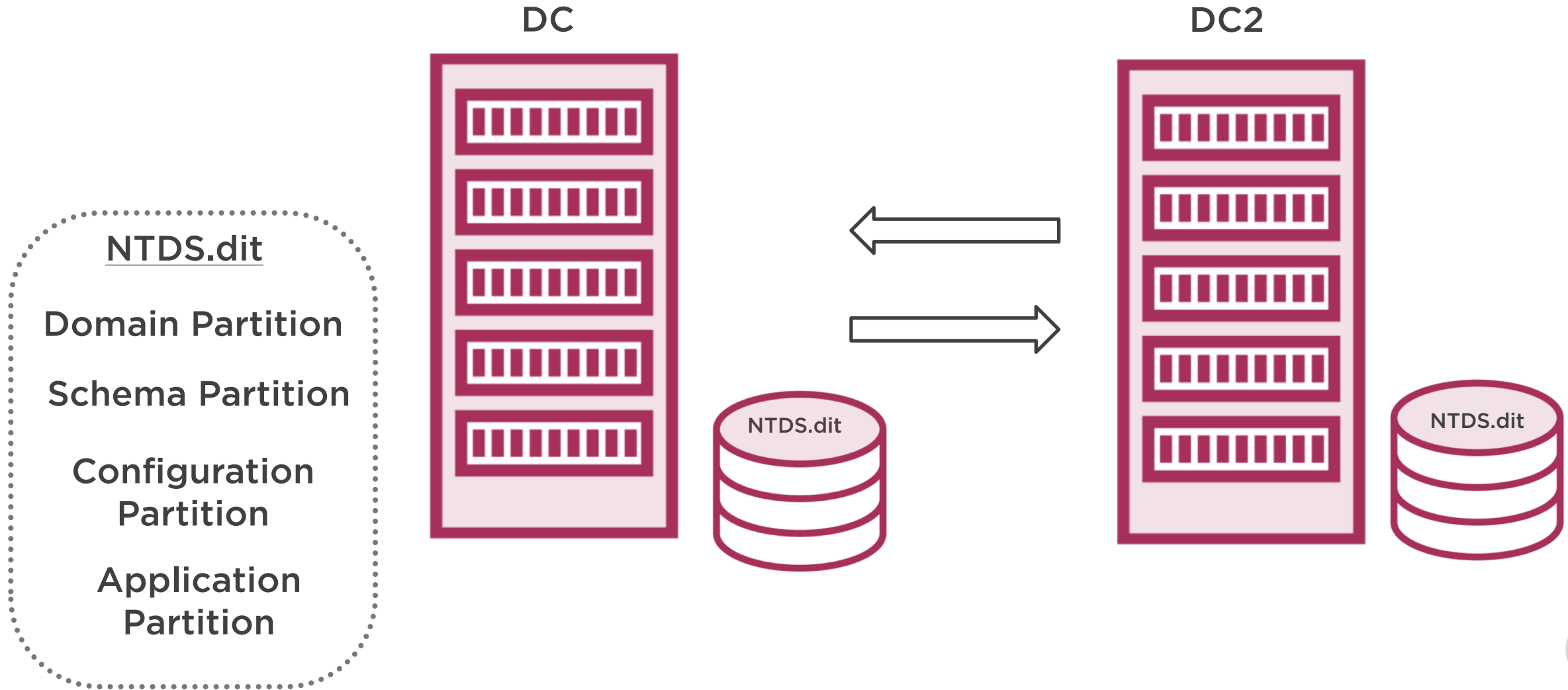

Where Is Information Replicated?

**Replicated inside a
domain**

Domain partition

**Replicated inside a
forest**

**Schema partition,
configuration partition, global
catalog**



Active Directory Sites



What Are Active Directory Sites?

One or more IP subnets
connected by high speed,
reliable links

Usually aligned to a physical
location but not always

Provides a boundary within
which replication takes place
freely

Sites allow
servers/users/applications to
locate local services
